## CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING

### Prosecco Extra Dry DOC - Italy

7.9 36

A classic example of the Glera grape grown in the Prosecco region. Pear and peach fruit on a lively, yet soft and generous palate.

### Paul Langier Brut NV

11.9 54

A blend of Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay grapes, an elegant and gentle mousse with fine flavours.

### Mattia Vezzola Brut Rosé - Italy

65

A blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay grapes. Brilliant, very fine and naturally persistent perlage with a complex bouquet of ripe fruit, citrus and floral notes. In the mouth it is full and elegant with structure and vivacity - the best expression of sparkling rosé.

### Lanson Brut Rosé Champagne

99

This famous cuvée is made from selected Pinot Noir grapes with nearly a dozen different crus, mainly coming from the South and North parts of the Montagne de Reims.

### Bollinger Special Cuvée

109

Special Cuvée is the purest expression of Bollinger's house style. Its biscuity nose is endowed with hints of white fruit and the rich, full bodied palate is perfectly balanced by fresh acidity and a soft, delicate mousse.

### Grand Siècle, Laurent Perrier NV

259

The very best growth, harvest and blend of Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier grapes. This is prestige handcrafted cuvée that has a unique depth, finesse, complexity and consistency with a remarkable length of honeyed, nutty flavours.

## ROSÉ

### Pinot Grigio Blush, Previata - Italy

6.9 26.9

From the region of Veneto, a dry, elegant Pinot Grigio Blush, soft, coppery-pink in colour, a delicate and fruity bouquet, soft on the palate.

### Côtes de Provence Rosé, J.L. Quinson - France

38

Made from the classic Provence rosé blend of Grenache, Syrah and Cinsaut. It has a generous bouquet with aromas of ripe red fruits, such as fresh strawberry and notes of blackcurrant and violet that present themselves on the palate, with the addition of grapefruit and other citrus notes.

### Whispering Angel, Château d'Esclans - France

69

Award winning, Whispering Angel is a benchmark of classic Côtes de Provence rosé. Adored by wine lovers around the world, the wine has evocative flavours of grapefruit and citrus, combined with refreshing acidity.

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## WHITE WINE

### La Sibiliana Grillo Roceno - Italy

6.9 26.9

From Sicily, a magnificent expression of Grillo. The nose presents notes of blossoms and white peach, subtly supplemented by fine citrus, and is a symphony in the mouth. A beautiful wine with character and ego.

### Pinot Grigio, Canaletto - Italy

7.9 30

From the region of Venezia, an elegant dry wine with floral notes and fresh flavours which provide a refreshingly crisp finish.

### Sauvignon Veneto I.G.T - Italy

9.5 36

From the Veneto region, straw-yellow colour with greenish reflections whose nose presents a typical herbaceous fragrance with notes of elderflower. Its freshness is matched by a pleasantly soft, rounded fruit accent.

### Clark Estate Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough - New Zealand

10.5 40

Selected from the Awatere Valley in Marlborough, New Zealand's premier Sauvignon Blanc growing regions. Fresh and vibrant on the palate with notes of gooseberry, passion fruit, grapefruit and tropical fruits with a striking minerality and a long crisp finish.

### Soave Classico, Bolla - Italy

42

From the Veneto region, made from selected Garganega grapes from the classic area on the hills of Soave near Verona. Delicate flowery and tropical fruity notes with hints of candied apricot on the palate.

### Gavi di Gavi, La Merlina - Italy

46

From Piedmont, Gavi, produced in the foothills of the Liguria Apennines just south of the of Novi Ligure, is Piedmont's leading white wine. This small, family run estate produces a prime example; a refined but intense, tangy dry white, with an intriguing hint of lime.

### Costaripa Pievecroce Lugana D.O.C - Italy

49

From the Lombardia region. Pale yellow in colour with green highlights. Fragrant with delicate notes of apple. An elegant and full wine with fine intensity.

### Domaine Philippe Gouley, Petit Chablis - France

62

From the Burgundy region. This Chablis has a crisp citrusy vibrant acidity, good balance and the typical bone-dry, minerality flavour of the Burgundy region that makes Chablis so popular and delightful.

### Puligny Montrachet, Domaine Chanson - France

139

From the Burgundy region. 100% Chardonnay, pleasant and bursting with ripe tropical fruit characters, balanced by concentrated limey acidity and a lick of spicy oak.

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## RED WINE

### Syrah, La Sibiliana Roceno - Italy

6.9 26.9

From Sicily, elegant and desirable, this is a full and generous wine. Intense aromas of cherry and wild plum, complimented by a stunningly sweet bouquet of blackberry liquor paired with a subtle toasty oak note.

### Miravigna Montepulciano d'Abruzzo - Italy

7.9 30

From the region of Abruzzo, Deep ruby red in colour with a pleasantly intense bouquet. Dry, harmonious and full-bodied with hints of vanilla and red fruit.

### Primitivo del Salento, Vinosia Orus - Italy

9.5 38

From Campania, spectacular concentration, intensity and elegance. Surprisingly deep and clean with incredibly smooth tannins.

### Valpolicella Classico Domini Veneti - Italy

48

From the Veneto region, the style of this wine focuses on the typical and traditional profile of the Valpolicella region. It is ruby red in colour, warm, medium-bodied and velvety, with balanced tannins.

### Chianti Classico Lamole Eticheta Bianca - Italy

59

Full, clean fragrances of forest fruits, smooth and velvety with good persistence. Bright ruby red colour, a floral bouquet along with scents of red berries and aromatic herbs. In the mouth it is generous and fresh, with extremely fine tannins that integrate splendidly with the tangy and crisp fruit notes.

### Barolo, Luigi Oddero, DOCG - Italy

84

From Piedmont, 100% Nebbiolo grapes. Bright garnet red colour which tends towards brick red with age. The nose is rich and complex with notes of forest fruit, herbs, dry flowers, licorice and pine. Long and persistent finish.

### Amarone Classico Della Valpolicella - Italy

99

From the Veneto region, Corvina blend, intense bouquet of mature red fruit (marasca cherry, plum, blackcurrants), of black cherry and raspberry jam, nutmeg and chocolate. Full, round, great body and structure, warm, persistent and intense to the palate.

### Brunello Di Montalcino, Col D'Orcia - Italy

109

From the Tuscany region. 100% Sangiovese di Toscana, offering an entertaining array of red and black berry fruits, spices and oaky aromas. Medium to full-bodied, with a richly complex middle and an everlasting, elegant finish.

### Château Lynch Bages, Pauillac 2008 - France

299

From the Bordeaux region, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot grapes. The freshness of the fruit on the nose, finding subtle harmony with the wood. On the palate, it is rounded, smooth and mellowed.
